Summary:

While the date of establishment is 1990, Roger Milner purchased the property in 1975, intending to plant a vineyard having worked for three years at Reynella winery in South Australia. Four hectares of vines were planted (chiefly by friends) but his then career in mineral exploration meant the vines were neglected and ultimately ploughed in. In the mid-1980's he returned with Jane Holt, and together they began the construction of the stone house-cum-winery. Planting of the existing 7 hectares of vineyard commenced in 1990, around the time that Jane commenced her viticultural studies at Charles Sturt University (she completed the course in 1993, and has since completed a subsequent wine science degree course in 2000). Until 1997 the grapes were sold to others, the first vintage (from 1997) being released in November 1998. The wines are distributed.... Not surprisingly, the limited quantity sells out with great speed. Exports to the US.
